History Highlights

- 1936 founded
- 1944 led the way for Amendment 35 establishing the Arkansas Game and Fish Commission as a constitutional agency empowered to create and enforce wildlife regulations
- 1946 began publishing *Arkansas Out of Doors*
- 1960 began annual (Governor's) Conservation Achievement Awards
- 1962 joined with Ozark Society to fight damming of Buffalo River
- 1980/90's helped develop and pass Amendment 75, establishing the statewide 1/8 Cent Conservation Sales Tax








Why the Private Lands Leadership Academy?




